



Dr. Oba T'Shaka

Dr. T'Shaka is a warrior scholar, renowned public speaker, professor, workshop leader, author, leader, organizer and visionary of exceptional influence who addresses audiences in the United States, Britain, France, Rotterdam and Africa. For 38 years Dr. T'Shaka was a Professor at San Francisco State University, where he is now Professor Emeritus. Dr. Nathan Hare says, "Oba T'Shaka (is) one of the key social philosophers in the Afro-American race today." The late Dr. Asa Hilliard, a great educator and scholar said of Dr. Oba T'Shaka, "he is one of the most powerful

deep thinkers in the world today. When my family and I arrived in San Francisco in 1963, Oba T'Shaka was a young powerful leader in the middle of the civil rights struggle. Since that time he has been totally consistent as an uncompromising truth seeker, visionary, organizer and leader in African liberation in the United States and on the African continent. He has published newspapers. He has led organizations. He has been and is a courageous activist." Dr. Oba T'Shaka is an organic scholar whose scholarship emerged out of the Black Liberation movement. In the course of organizing T'Shaka (then Bill Bradley) underwent an awakening that led him to realize that his mind was under remote control. This led him to undergo a process of re-education under masters, a process that continues to this day. This lifelong process of re-education would transform T'Shaka into an Scholar/Warrior. The lessons learned through study would guide his organizing, and the lessons learned from battles for Black liberation would shape his study and writings. The complexities of the struggles that T'Shaka led would direct his studies and shape his thought. The central aim of T'Shaka's organizing and writing is to contribute to the development of just societies in the U.S., Africa and throughout the world, based upon the most just feature of African and African American cultures. In the course of his organizing Dr. T'Shaka then known as Bill Bradley while leading the San Francisco Freedom Movement collaborated with Malcolm X, and Martin Luther King around movement strategies. He worked with the Deacons For Self Defense, working with them in Louisiana in 1965, and with their West Coast representative Chilly Willy. Dr. T'Shaka marched with Dr. King in Selma Alabama in 1965, serving as a March leader in the Selma to Montgomery march. In 1995 T'Shaka addressed The Million Man March speaking to 950,000 Black men and providing follow-up strategy for the March. Dr. Phillip McGee former Dean of the College of Ethnic Studies at San Francisco State University observed that Dr. Oba T'Shaka's scholarship has been "field tested." Dr. T'Shaka's writings are half paradigm shaping and half application or practice. T'Shaka's writings cover areas of knowledge that he has internalized and lives, and the practice that he has mastered. Oba T'Shaka is the author of five books, each of which grows out of years of study and organizational practice. Dr. T'Shaka is a rare blend of a Master Scholar, Master Warrior, and charismatic speaker, who's many years of organizing and

scholarship, has provided a rich body of experience for writing, teaching and public speaking.
