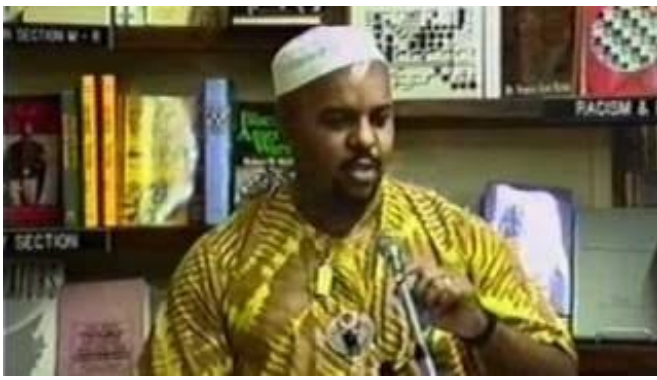




Imhotep as history's first recorded multi-genius.

Activism and Community Impact

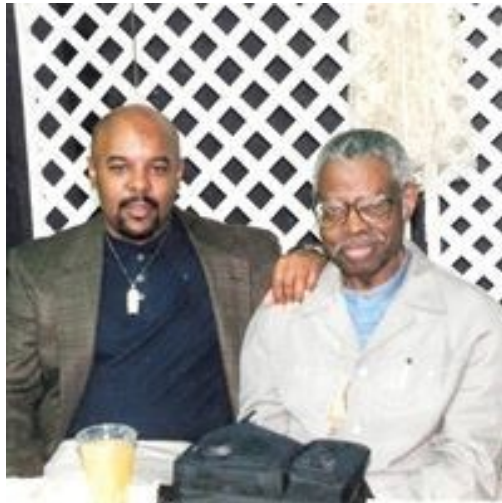
He was an active participant in organizations such as the Association for the Study of Classical African Civilizations (ASCAC), attending landmark conferences in the 1980s and 1990s, and heavily influencing Black cultural and historical education in Los Angeles and globally.

Family

He was married to Sherry Ater, and he is the father of certified astrologer and wellness entrepreneur Tamerri Ater, with whom he collaborated to highlight the historical roots of African traditions and astrology.

Passing

Mathu Ater passed away on September 23, 2026, at the age of 70, widely eulogized by fellow African-centered historians and community scholars as an elder and teacher.

was an African-centered scholar, architectural

specialist, educator, and lecturer known for his work in Egyptology and ancient African history.

Apprenticeship:

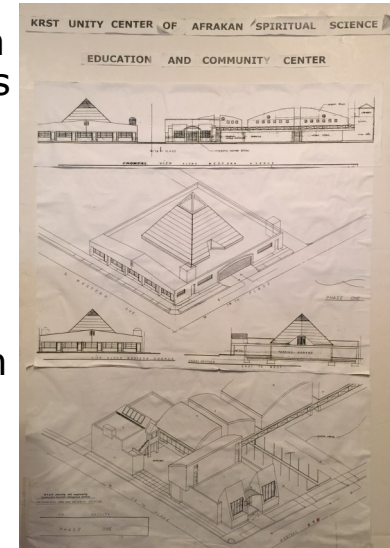
He completed an 11-year apprenticeship under prominent Los Angeles architect Lester O. Bankhead, where he developed a foundational expertise in analyzing religious and ancient architecture.

Afro-centric Studies

Beginning around 1981, he studied under or engaged with prominent Pan-African scholars including Dr. Yosef Ben-Jochannan (Dr. Ben), John Henrik Clarke, and Cheikh Anta Diop.
