These creative nonfiction memoirs use the principles of Sankofa and ancestral wisdom to examine and document Queen Shamala's path of self-discovery and re-discovery from abuse, racism and patriarchy.

These early catalysts for change connected the author with her purpose and passion. The first book Black Butterfly Soul Songs was re-published in 2025 due to copyright abridgements by the initial publisher.

Dr. Rev. Queen Shamala Davis Smith is the mother of two daughters, Yealang Shakir, an acclaimed entrepreneurial chef, and Renetta Roberson, a registered nurse.

Touching the lives of many young people, Queen Shamala worked as a secondary school counselor for over 30 years with the Los Angeles Unified School District. Her grandson Malik and her granddaughter Malikainspire Queen as she lives her life healing and loving.

As an ordained minister, licensed metaphysical practitioner and a student of the African spiritual practice Ifa, Queen Shamala facilitates light healing sessions, distance healing, guided meditations, ancestral walking sticks, queen/king initiation crownings, painting classes, rites of passages and her signature Sankofa-based life writing at her healing center, University of Creative Light Initiation Systems (UCLIS).

Years of studying under many Sbas (teachers), cathartic experiences, creative writing and soul healing produced her next book, a Sankofa graphical writing guide: Re-Right Your Life: A Sankofa Writing Project Handbook. Today, various students attend Sankofic-related writing classes at Queen Shamala's school, UCLIS, located in Gardena, California.

Dr. Rev. Queen Shamala Ifawuyi Smith has lived in the Los Angeles area since 1965, migrating from North Carolina.

She earned an associate's degree in psychology at Los Angeles Southwest Community College; a bachelor's degree in psychology from the University of Southern California; a master's degree in psychology from California State University, Los Angeles; and a Doctor of Theology from Christ is the Answer University in Florida. Queen Shamala recently completed a PhD in AfRaKan Spiritual Science from the University of Creative Life Initiation System (UCLIS) in Gardena, CA. Queen Shamala is executive director of this learning center.

Queen Shamala's first book, *Black Butterfly Soul Songs*, expresses the author's soul transformation in poetry. It was published in 2017, eleven years after her retirement from 30 years of working with thousands of high school students. The first book, in the autobiographical trilogy - "Initiation in Love" - Breaking the Cycles of Pain Soul Secrets was published in 2022. The second book in the trilogy, *The Journey Let Us Cheer the Weary Traveler*, was released in 2024. The trilogy completed its cycle in 2026, with the publication
